Mental Health

- Utilization up 2-3% for fall. Offering 50% inperson appointments to balance needs and offer workplace flexibility
- U-Will, new mental health platform, has served about 50 students so far but many saying they'd rather wait for UHS appointment. Wait times are longer in spring so some students may take more advantage of U-Will.
- UHS Psychiatry Dept. has now moved back to the umbrella of Mental Health Services from Medical Services. New Psychiatry director working to remove barriers to access, possibly telehealth in the future.
- Embedded Mental Health provider positions have been falling into place in Engineering, CALS, Athletics

Operations

- SSFC passed the UHS budget for next year.
- Continued conversations regarding construction/renovation
- Working on fix for IT framework/firewall issues that have been ongoing for years
- Hired new IT Program Manager from DoIT to help with IT projects
