<p>2. Summer Eligibility and Health Fee</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discussed the Summer Health Fee access and cost. Students can pay \$120 for the summer to have access to UHS services for those who will be on campus during the summer, or those who have a need to have continued care through the summer. Barriers have been noted regarding some students being unable to pay the fee. UHS has been able to use grant funds in the past to help pay for those students. During the pandemic, the summer fee was waived. Currently have some funding from Student Affairs for this year to help those who need support. For the future, will look for strategy for a more sustainable way to pay for those students who cannot afford the fee, possibly through donation or other means. Will continue discussion in fall.
